

Terms of use for libraries and institutions

The International Journal of Music (IJM) does not issue or require the agreement of a formal license for institutional access to its magazines. Rather, it has chosen to adopt a co-operative and collaborative approach as exemplified by the SERU (Shared E-Resource Understanding) approach to e-resource subscriptions. This approach recognises that the provision of timely, high quality materials and their protection is in the mutual interests of all parties, and offers savings in time and cost by enabling access within a framework of shared understanding and good faith.

In the absence of a separate license agreement, the IJM follows the SERU guidelines, as published at the NISO SERU website: https://www.niso.org/committees/SERU/.
